

## **SCHOLARSHIP POLICY**

### **Purpose:**

Policy of DSCE on award of scholarship to the students is meant for framing guidelines for providing scholarships to the students under the following categories with the intention of motivate them in their activities by providing financial support:

1. Merit Scholarship
2. Scholarship Based on Economic status.
3. Sports Scholarship
4. Scholarship for the wards of Ex-service man & Military officials
5. Scholarship for the siblings/wards of alumni
6. Scholarship for the wards of teaching/non-teaching/technical staff members of the Institution.

### **Policy Statements:**

#### **1. Merit Scholarship\***

This scholarship is provided to the students, who have secured good percentage or cut off in their 12<sup>th</sup> board examinations, during their admission to the Institution. To continue with the scholarship in the following academic years, the student must clear all his/her subjects in every semester.

#### **2. Scholarship Based on Economic status\***

This scholarship is provided to the students, who have been performing well in academics but face adversities during the study programme and unable to manage even the minimum financial requirements for carrying on with their studies. The award of the scholarship is on a case to case basis as decided by the Managing trustee.

#### **3. Sports Scholarship\***

At the end of even semester, this scholarship is provided to the students who have excelled in the Intercollegiate/Zonal/State/National/International sports/games events in that academic years

based on the recommendations of the Physical Director and subject to the approval of the Managing trustee.

**4. Scholarship for the wards of Ex-service man & Military officials\***

This scholarship is provided to the students, who are the wards of Ex-service man & Military officials. The award of the scholarship is on a case to case basis as decided by the Managing trustee.

**5. Scholarship for the siblings/wards of alumni\***

This scholarship is provided to the students, who are the siblings/wards of alumni. The award of the scholarship is on a case to case basis as decided by the Managing trustee.

**6. Scholarship for the siblings/wards of teaching/non teaching/technical staff members of the Institution\*.**

This scholarship is provided to the students, who are the siblings/wards of teaching/non teaching/technical staff members of the Institution (currently employed). The award of the scholarship is on a case to case basis as decided by the Managing trustee.

**\*Students who are availing any other scholarship are not eligible for the above mentioned scholarships**
